

American Disabilities Act (ADA) Compliance Policy

It is the policy of Camp Doublecreek (Doublecreek Farm Inc.) to comply with all the relevant and applicable provisions of the Americans with Disability Act ("ADA"). Camp Doublecreek will not discriminate against any potential camper with respect to any terms, privileges or conditions of admission because of a person's physical or mental disability. Camp Doublecreek also will make reasonable accommodation required by law for all qualified disabled potential campers, provided that the individual is otherwise capable of participating in camp related activities and provided the accommodations required do not create an undue hardship due to difficulty or expense.

This policy prevails throughout every aspect of the admission process. In order to achieve this goal, we wanted to bring to your attention the following policies of Camp Doublecreek:

- It is Camp Doublecreek's policy is to consider all determinations of potential accommodations for campers with a disability on a case by case basis. Camp Doublecreek will strongly consider reasonable modifications that do not fundamentally alter the nature of the services provided by Camp Doublecreek.
- All decisions on acceptance of a camper to Camp Doublecreek which may
 qualify for the protections under the ADA are made in a collective consultation
 with the Director, Medical Coordinator, the camper's physician and parents or
 legal guardians of such camper. The safety of any camper has been and will
 continue to be the primary concern regarding the potential admission of any
 child to attend Camp Doublecreek.
- Camp Doublecreek has a licensed medical professional on site at all times when campers are present. Staff will be trained in general first aid and activities staff will have an additional CPR certification. If any camper requires special medical assistance beyond scope traditionally provided by our staff, Camp Doublecreek will make reasonable efforts to cooperate with a camper's parent, or legal guardian, and physician to consider whether Camp Doublecreek can assist in making reasonable accommodations for such child with the staff in place.
